Project Overview

SENTINEL-360 is a smart, predictive intelligence system designed to help the Texas Department of Criminal Justice (TDCJ) detect behavioral red flags, prevent security threats, log incident command events, and modernize correctional operations.

Core Objectives

- Detect potential inmate suicide, violence, or unrest before it happens
- Provide officers with proactive alerts and visual behavior tracking
- Log ICS reports, responder details, and timelines with precision
- Improve communication, mental health referrals, and staff safety

System Modules

- Red Flag Behavior Visualizer
- ICS Event Log (with A-Responder tracking)
- Inmate Profile Viewer with Alerts
- Incident Timeline Tracker
- Rehabilitation Planner & Mental Health Referral Logs
- Admin Dashboard with Role-Based Access

Deployment Requirements

The system can be deployed on secure, TDCJ-approved servers or through a custom on-premise integration. No internet access is required for the base system. Optional cloud-sync is available.
